FOREHEAD

Regular Botox shots for migraines have (bonus!) kept Kristin's forehead smooth and wrinkle-free. "She may also have had an ultrasound brow lift [\$1.6K]," says dermatologist Dr. Simon Ourian.

NOSE

Talk about a restaging! "Her nose is narrower and has a somewhat bony tip, which is often an indication of a rhinoplasty," notes plastic surgeon Dr. Barry M. Weintraub. Cost? Up to \$12,500.

CHEEKS

Dermal fillers such as Juvéderm Voluma have replaced facial volume loss due to aging, shares Dr. Ourian. "To make her eyes appear I would reduce filler below them."

CHIN

"Kristin originally had a rather pointed chin," observes Dr. Weintraub. "But now her jawline is more squared-off and wider, indicative of a chin augmentation [up to \$7,000]."

Kristin: Bright Lights, Big Botox!

Unlike most stars, Kristin Chenoweth makes no secret of her long-running Botox habit. The Tony winner confesses she started twice-yearly injections of the muscle-freezing toxin at age 35 — she's now 46! — but insists her

motive wasn't vanity. After suffering weekly bouts of debilitating migraines, her doctor suggested "five shots of Botox across my eyebrows," Kristin recalls. "I haven't had a full-blown headache since!" Nor has she gained any significant wrinkles! But

experts suggest the actress has also reached beyond her headache remedy to retain her youthful features. While Beverly Hills celeb dermatologist Dr. Simon Ourian notes Kristin's apparent use of dermal fillers to keep her skin plump, NYC plastic surgeon

Dr. Barry M. Weintraub believes she has gone under the knife for a nose job, chin augmentation and possible upper-eyelid lift. "Her lids were quite heavy before," notes Dr. Weintraub (who, like Dr. Ourian, does not call Kristin a patient). "And there now ap-

pears to be less skin between her eyelashes and eyebrows." The results? Dr. Weintraub thinks she looks a tad overdone. But this Broadway babe won't let a bad review get her down. "Life's so short," says Kristin. "We might as well enjoy it." **LS**
